I forgot to mention in the last month's newsletter a word of thanks for all who showed to help un-cover the KC pool. It's really a cool feeling when you a job of this size comes together so easily. I want to list the names but am afraid I'd miss someone but I will say that I thank those of you who answered the call and came through when we really needed you.

I would like to clear up some pool membership confusion. All KC members are automatic pool members however your family members are not. For them to be pool members there is a \$90 pool registration. This registration fee entitles all family members living at the resident of the KC member to swim. Everyone must understand that the cost of running the pool is not cheap it takes everyone to do their part to cover the cost. Plus it's really not fair when we have members that pay but only show up to see members who are not on the list taking advantage of the pool. There is a pool membership list on the bulletin board, if your name is not on the list your family is not registered pool members. We also have a \$3 guest fee for members who would like to bring guest. Each member is allowed to bring the same guest up to 3 times after that it's only fair to pay family membership. I've had many calls from people outside our Knights of Columbus / St. Joseph community call me and ask me if they can join. If we can't collect from our members we will have no choice but to open it up to everyone so we can cover the cost of operating the pool.
